

Subscription Agreement: Inactive Peace Officers

Thank you for choosing PATROL. To initiate your PATROL subscription, this form must be completed, signed, and returned to the League of Minnesota Cities Insurance Trust (LMCIT) via email to <u>patrol@lmc.org</u>. <u>PLEASE NOTE: As of the date of this agreement, your PATROL subscription will</u> <u>automatically renew each year on January 1 unless you cancel your subscription in writing by</u> <u>the previous December 1.</u> The information being collected on this form will be used to enroll you in the PATROL subscription. For notification purposes, Minn. Stat. 13.356 classifies your phone number, email and physical address as private data about you. You may choose not to provide some or all of this private data, but it may hinder our ability to provide and renew your PATROL subscription.

LMCIT and the Individual agree to the following terms and conditions:

- I. This Agreement is entered into between the Individual and LMCIT.
- II. LMCIT will annually verify the Individual's POST license number with POST. If it is in inactive status, the Individual will pay the annual inactive officer rate. If it has lapsed, the Individual will pay the private individual rate. Please provide the following information:

- III. This Agreement will automatically renew each year and will be in effect unless one of the following occurs:
 - a. LMCIT receives written notice of cancellation from the Individual by December 1;
 - b. LMCIT in its sole discretion determines to discontinue or limit the availability of PATROL, provided that LMCIT will return a pro rata share of that year's annual subscription fee to the Individual based on the number of months in that year the Individual does not have access to PATROL because of LMCIT's action.

- IV. The Individual acknowledges that PATROL is not a substitute for competent and timely legal advice and that PATROL cannot and does not take into account all aspects of a particular situation. While LMCIT endeavors to make PATROL as accurate as possible, there are several reasons beyond LMCIT's control why the accuracy of PATROL information cannot be guaranteed. These include but are not limited to the following:
 - a. The delivery format and time spent on topics through PATROL does not allow for a detailed discussion of subtle legal issues that could turn out to be important in a particular law enforcement situation.
 - b. Laws can change without notice to LMCIT, individuals developing PATROL contentand materials, or PATROL subscribers.
 - c. Future legal decisions may depart from current precedent outlined through PATROL.
 - d. Individuals using PATROL may not understand the intended meaning of the course materials.

Because of these limitations and as a condition of subscribing to PATROL, the Individual hereby waives any and all claims related to the use of PATROL or reliance on PATROL content and materials. The Individual agrees not to bring a claim or lawsuit against the League of Minnesota Cities Insurance Trust, its employees, officers, agents, board members, contractors, subcontractors or affiliates, arising in any way out of reliance on information provided through PATROL.

- V. The Individual acknowledges that this Agreement does not grant it any ownership or other legal interest in PATROL or PATROL materials.
- VI. Information about the courses you take and the scores you receive in PATROL are considered private data about you. Unless you provide consent to release this information, or LMCIT has been court ordered to produce this information, LMCIT will only provide this information to you and to POST representative(s) for purposes of Peace Officer licensure. You may choose not to take PATROL courses but doing so will exclude you from earning accredited Peace Officer training through the PATROL program.
- VII. Nothing in this Agreement creates any right in any person not a party to it. Neither the Individual nor LMCIT waives any immunity from or limitation on liability to which either or both are entitled under law.
- VIII. LMCIT may modify the terms of this Agreement by providing written notice to the Individual by November 1 of any year, in which case the modifications may take effectno sooner than the next January 1.

The Individual has read this entire agreement and accepts the terms.
